August 7 was the date for one of KIB's favorite events – the Mayor and KIB Annual Awards. We paid tribute to 11 groups and individuals who have made a positive impact in the Irving community. We returned to the Jack D. Huffman Building again this year, and welcomed back our honorary presenter, Mayor Stopfer, and our emcee, Cathy Whiteman. Employees from the North Irving Home Depot gave 16 hours of volunteer time in assembling 67 shadowbox kits and 35 fire rescue boat kits, which they then donated to KIB. Staff visited two different day care centers – Adventure Discovery Center on August 11 and Leaders Bilingual Academy on August 24 – where a total of 36 children enjoyed painting their own boats or boxes. Many thanks to Home Depot for this donation, and to the day cares for welcoming us.

KIB partnered with Pacific Dental Services for a cleanup at T.W. Richardson Grove Park on August 19. The 22 adults and 3 youth volunteers combined for 75 hours, and collected 101 pounds of trash and 17 pounds of recyclables. This was part of the company's 13th annual "Smile Generation Serve Day," an event where they provide donated dental services as well as engage in community service projects with local nonprofits.
